### LOOK A BOOK! BY: DIANE SIBLEY

With less than a hundred days left until the election you can do a cram session on most things political by reading Everything You Think You Know About Politics...and Why You're Wrong. Author Kathleen Jamieson starts with a quiz and I must admit, it was a humbling experience. The text is straight forward and easily read and she uses statistics only when they're needed to make comparisons more easily understood. The book was published in 2000, so it may be a little outdated in that it won't include much about former President George W. Bush's campaign, but that doesn't take away from all the analysis and conclusions of the author based on prior elections.

The book is heavily weighted toward understanding campaigns and the effects of advertising. It is divided into four parts: "The Content and Effects of Campaigns," "Candidate Advertising," "Issue-Advocacy," and "The Influence of News".

Jamieson uses lots of anecdotal evidence to explain her conclusions. Some of the more interesting chapters deal with the gender gap in political knowledge, the effect of negative attack ads, the effects of debates, media bias and the effect of a candidate's stated agenda on the electorate.

My first reading of Everything You Think You Know About Politics...and Why You're Wrong was a cursory one, but as the election nears, I'm going to dig a little deeper, make some notes and astound and amaze my family as we watch ads and debates and pundit sound bites together. And even if they don't think I'm any smarter than before -I read the book, at least I'll feel better.
