
NOTE FROM THE CHAIR

LOOK ! A 600K!

Once when I was a kid, I read a novel that took place during the years of the Barbary pirates. I apparently didn't like the book and didn't finish it, because until just recently I was still in the dark about who they were and why we fought them. I was looking for a book to give my history loving grandson and came across "Thomas Jefferson and the Tripoli Pirates - The Forgotten War that Changed American History." I bought a copy for Jake and one for myself for this quarter's issue of Kickin' News.


"T.J. and the Pirates" as I shall all it, was published in 2015 and quickly became a New York Times best seller. It's an easy read and succeeds in enlightening readers on the political issues revolving around the Adams and Jefferson presidencies as they related to conflicts as they related to conflicts in trade with England, France and other European countries.

The book is an action packed recounting of the North African pirates who supported despots and enriched themselves by stealing ships and goods and demanding monetary tribute from mostly British and French merchant vessels. For years European nations had come to believe that the best way to deal with these pirates and save their merchant ships was to pay tribute to the four Muslim nations of the Barbary Coast (Morocco, Tunis, Algiers and Tripoli,) and hope for the best.

The Barbary pirates were Muslims, a few turncoat Europeans and an assortment of thugs. The Muslims believed the Qur'an justified any actions taken against the Christians . Prisoners were starved, forced to break and carry rocks from the hills and mountains down to the sea and whipped for any perceived violation of rules. Prisoners could only be released if they escaped, converted to Islam. Or had their sentence nullified by tribute paid by their home country.

President Adams knew that our young and highly indebted nation could not afford the tribute that was being demanded, but America needed to build ships for trade and defense. We needed ships to carry our goods to Europe and we couldn't afford to lose a single one. He believed the U.S. should negotiate with the pirates, pay the tribute and build up our trade with Europe. While Jefferson understood the need for trade, he believed it was beneath the dignity of the United States to pay bribes to countries who supported piracy, captured, tortured and starved slaves and could not be trusted to honor any agreement they made to mend their ways. H also believed that the paying of tribute continued a very bad policy that could only lead to more of the same. Jefferson stepped up his efforts to take on the Barbary pirates.




Something else worth reading; and those who voted for the President - give yourselves a pat on the back.



WHEN WILL IT END ? ENOUGH IS ENOUGH! OPINION PIFCE

Enough is enough. Seriously, its been three weeks since the crazy Oregon militia took over (led by Ammon Bundy) the Malheur National Wildlife Refuge, about 39 miles east of Burns, Oregon. This refuge is managed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, therefore deeming it a federal building.

What is happening? Why have armed militia been allowed to occupy this building, because they are basically mad? A quick recap:

Spring 2014 - A 20 year dispute between Nevada rancher, Clive Bundy, and the U.S. Bureau of Land Management over 1 million in unpaid grazing fees leads to an armed conflict.

2015 - After an appeals court overturns Hammonds' original sentences, a federal judge issues new sentences of 5 years to both men, with credit for time served. Mid-December: Militants from states across the West begin assembling in the small town

Of Burns to protest the pending re-imprisonment of the Hammonds over what they describe as unjust federal land policies.

Jan. 2: After an estimated 300 marchers parade through Burns, supporting the Hammonds, a splinter group of armed protesters begin to occupy the headquarter of the National Wildlife Refuge, 30 miles south of Burns.

Jan. 3: Ammon Bundy, son of Clive Bundy and leader of the refuge occupants, says the group has no intention of violence unless the government acts against them.

Jan. 4: The Hammonds report to federal prison in California, but say they will seek clemency from the President. During a news conference, Harney County Sheriff, David Ward, tells the protesters to. "Go home."

Jan. 5: Ammon Bundy says they won't leave until local property owners have control over the refuge, or if the community shows they're no longer welcome. Ward says law enforcement is taking steps behind the scene to end the standoff.

Jan. 6: The burns Paiute tribe, which once held this land, calls on the militants to end the standoff. A nighttime scuffle between occupiers and an outside group sends one man to the hospital with a black eye. Jan. 7: The sheriff and Bundy meet on neutral ground to discuss ending the occupation. Gov. Kate Brown demands the protesters "decamp immediately." Jan. 8: Ammon Bundy says the group doesn't plan to leave for

now. WHAT?

Jan. 11: After a week, schools reopen in Burns. The militants destroy federal fencing, saying they had permission from the rancher whose cattle graze on private land adjoining the refuge. WHAT?

Jan. 112: The militants say they will reveal their exit plan at a meeting Friday evening. Jan.13: Rancher Tim Puckett says he didn't give the militants permission to destroy a publicly owned fence and is upset.





Jan. 15: The "exit strategy" doesn't happen after a dispute about where to hold the meeting. Authorities arrest the first person associated with the occupation, Kenneth Medenbach, 62, who drove a government truck to Burns and was accused of car theft.

Fast forward to now. Militia members from other states have joined the "cause." We now have FBI negotiators opening talks, trying to end this peacefully.

It is here that I finally ask the million dollar question: "If the militants were Black/Hispanic/Muslim (insert "other") would this still be happening? Not long ago the Black Lives Matter Movement peacefully (without weapons) organized a protest at the Mall of America. These young people were met by the Wisconsin police decked out in full riot gear and forcibly removed, losing their constitutional right to protest.


