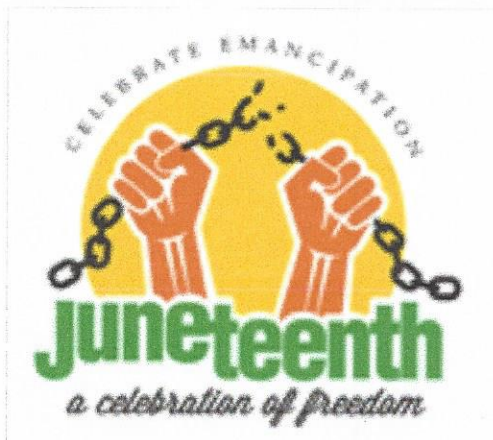


## Vote in the Primary on Tuesday, June 8th
