Do you want to help with Voter Registration?

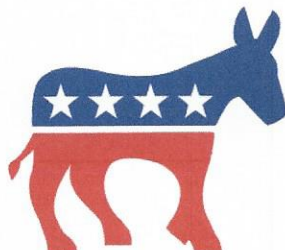
