Due to the need to know how much food to purchase in advance, there will be no walk-in ticket sales at the event.



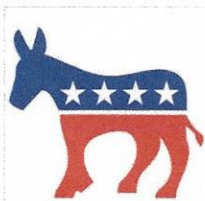
## New Project for the Environment Committee
